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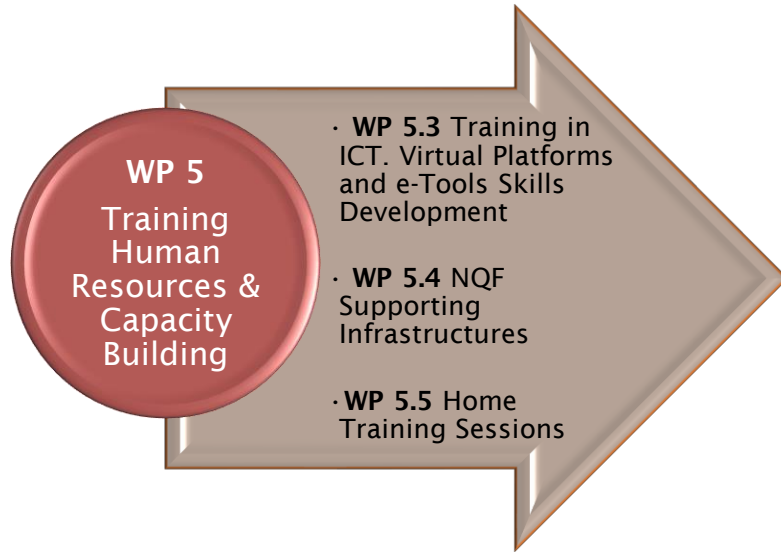
WP 5.4 NQF Supporting Infrastructures

By institution.

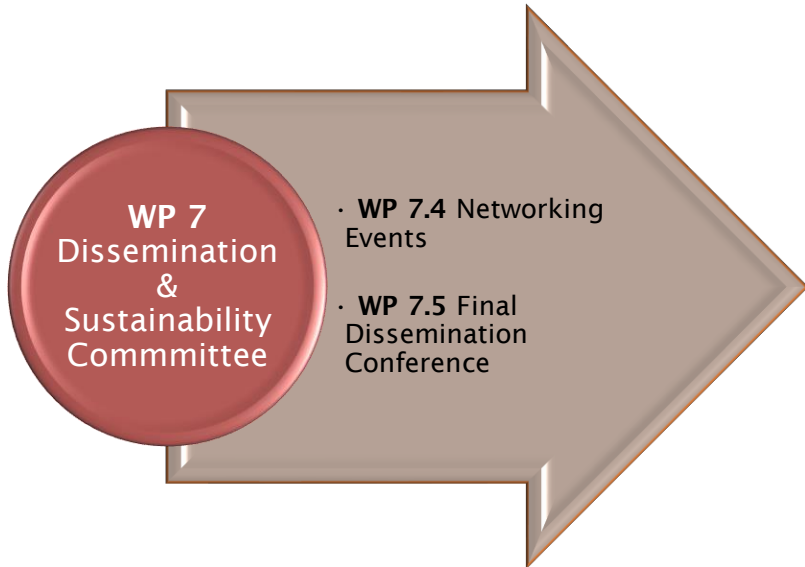

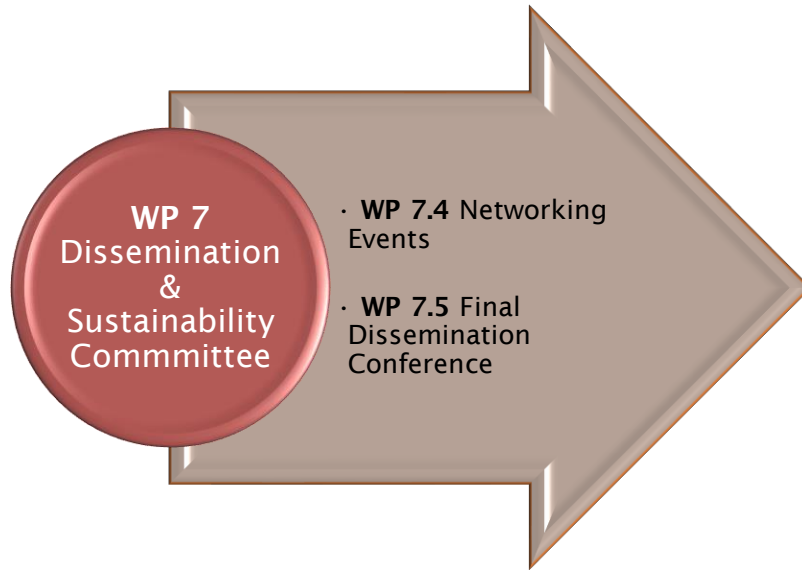

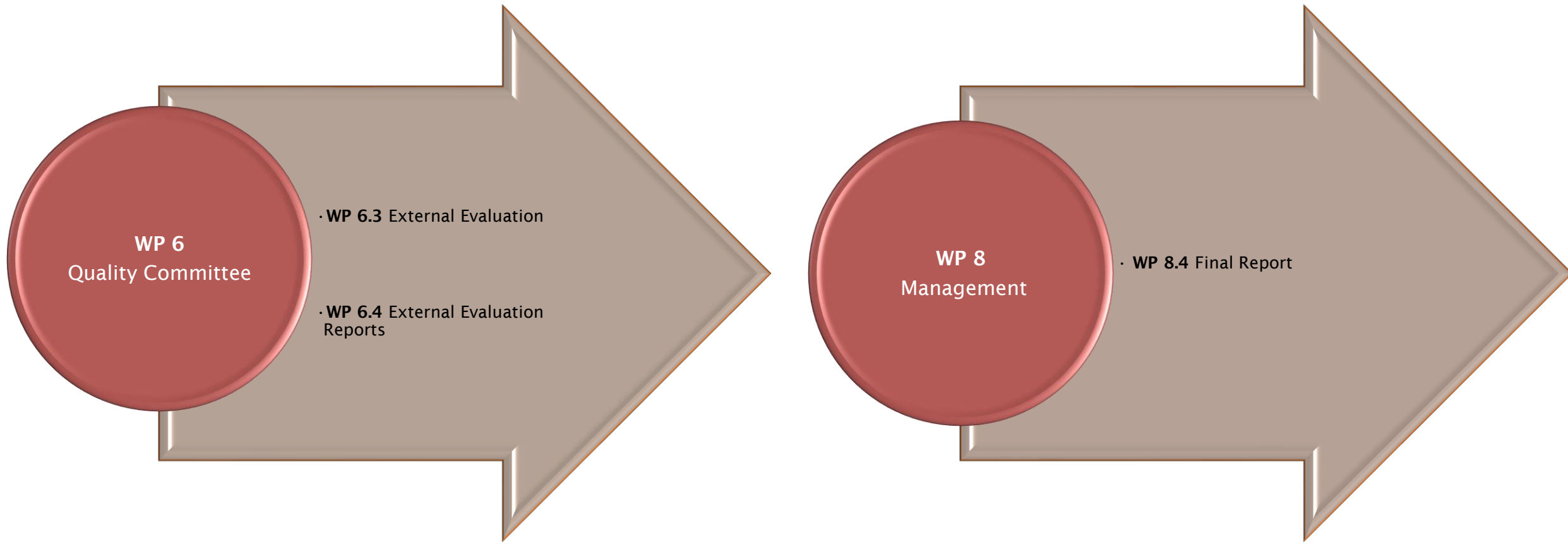
WP 7.5 Final Dissemination Conference

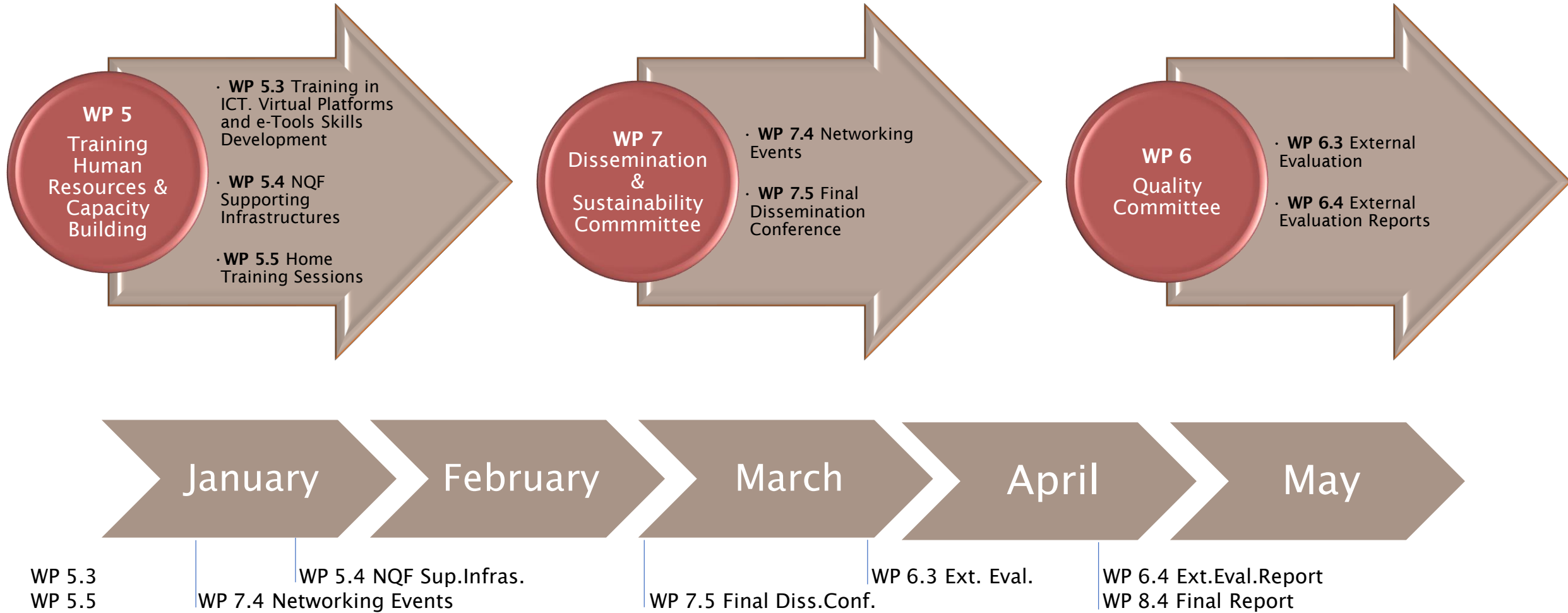
